The National Copyright Office (O.N.D.A) is a public institution of an industrial and commercial nature, endowed with legal personality and financial independence, but it is not exclusively for the protection of the interests and moral rights of producers of intellectual works and their rights .**
- 2. The National Copyright Office is placed under the supervision of the Ministry of Commerce.**
- 3. The administrative body of the National Copyright Office consists of a Director General, a Board of Directors, and a Financial Controller.**
- 4. The National Copyright Office does not exclusively guarantee the protection of the interests and moral rights of producers of intellectual works and their rights .**
- 5. The National Copyright Office administers and exercises all rights related to the public representation of authors' works and their exploitation by all means .**
- 6. The National Copyright Office is responsible for encouraging the production of intellectual works by creating appropriate conditions for this.**
- 7. The National Copyright Office ensures the protection of workers who fall within the traditional cultural heritage and folklore of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria, those registered abroad, as well as works of citizens in the public domain.**
- 8. The National Copyright Office undertakes all other project work that helps achieve these goals, including joining international organizations of authors that include similar bodies.**
- 9. Copyright protection does not require mandatory registration.**
- 10. The presence of the © copyright notice does not automatically mean that the work is protected.**
